I believe, a good start could be if I put here a collection of the referee reports and my replies. Of course, due to the referees' remarks and suggestions, the manuscripts were changed many times. Sometimes, therefore, the numbering of pages or equations, etc. can be confusing. I think however that the main ideas can be followed without such details.
